Job Summary: The Worship Leader is responsible for leading God-centered, Christ-exalting music that ministers to the church body and is performed with excellence; and to provide direction, oversight, and coordination of musical, artistic and technical elements of worship services; and to raise a team around him or her.

Job Duties:

- Oversee the Worship ministry including working with team leading sound, visuals, lighting, recording, and directly working with musicians and singers.
- Prayerfully set a vision for the Worship Ministry of NLCC with a plan to carry it out. Teach the vision to members of the worship ministry team.
- Choose songs for Sunday worship services in collaboration with worship team and pastoral staff.
- Provide leadership coordination for "special" worship services; explore and implement ways for using church musicians and vocalists in outreach opportunities.
- Demonstrate a passion for engaging the church in worship; be sensitive to the Spirit's leading.
- Coordinate use of electronic resources (microphones, monitors, etc.) with the AV team.
- Coordinate scheduling and leading music team rehearsals.
- Recruit, train, and mentor the volunteer music teams and grow the volunteer servant base.

- **CHARACTER**: Must first and foremost have a heart for God and lavish worship and be F.A.S.T.E.R.-Faithful/ Available/ Spirit-filled/ Teachable/ Equipper/ Reproducer.
